N=391 Email and mail invitations fielded online August 29-October 9, 2019 Margin of error +- 4.9

For this survey 391 American Fork City residents were sampled from the Utah state voter file, with emails appended from a third-party vendor. Survey invitations were sent via both email and mail; all interviews were completed online. The data were weighted to reflect the demographics of residents in American Fork City, specifically in regard to age, gender, and home ownership.
